

THE NEED FOR CONSERVATION OF INSECTS

Insect conservation can be imagined in the traditional African context. Many people simply don't like bugs, and an endangered bug will definitely mean nothing to such a person. In the Anthropogenic age, biodiversity is threatened on all sides. Majestic forests, charismatic whales, and colorful birds all face threats from direct exploitation or anthropogenic modification of habitats ([James MacDonald](#), 2017). The sight of a lone polar bear sitting on a shrinking ice floe is an iconic image of some of what the planet stands to lose from global warming. But there is another casualty of extinction that is all too often ignored: insects.



Many insects have very specific habitat or host plant requirements. As habitat is lost or converted, small or hidden creatures such as insects can disappear along with it. In fact, a study from Brazil estimates that up to half a million insects will go extinct in biodiversity hotspots alone in the near future (James MacDonald, 2017). That estimate does not include the other ~98 percent of the planet that doesn't count as a hotspot. Only about 950,000 species of insects had been described as of 1995, but the current estimate of existing insect species is between 3.6 and 10 million. Insects may go extinct without us even knowing they ever existed.

Why should we conserve Insects?

Insects, which include more than a million known species, represent roughly two-thirds of the described biodiversity on Earth. But they have a big PR problem - many think of insects as little more than crop-eating, disease-carrying jumper-munchers. But in reality, species fitting this bill are but a tiny part of an enormous picture.

A dominant narrative has emerged in an effort to clear the good name of our six-legged friends. Insects are the unsung heroes, the little things that run the world. This fact is undeniable. Insects are critical to the existence of the world as we know it, whether through pollinating plants, controlling populations of agricultural pests, or helping with the decomposition of animal waste.

However economic arguments can only take us so far.

Imagine a field of tomatoes. For an appreciable harvest flowers must be pollinated. To achieve this farmers might choose to enlist the help of native pollinators by setting aside part of their land for flowering plants. In some cases this works exceptionally well. For instance, a recent paper has shown that converting 5-8% of arable



land to pollinator habitat supports [greater or equivalent crop yields](#), even after accounting for loss of field area.

But how much insect diversity do we need to support ecosystem services? Generally speaking, a more diverse species assemblage means [higher levels of functioning](#). Keeping with our pollinator analogy, we might find that two species of bee can provide a greater service of pollination than one species - even if the overall numbers of bees are the same. A three-species community might perform better still. But not every species plays an equally important economic role and the presence of a dozen rarer bee species may provide no additional monetary benefit. Recent research shows the majority of pollination services of agricultural crops by wild bees are performed by a [tiny handful of species](#); the authors argue that crop pollination is not a sufficient argument to justify bee conservation. This exemplifies the danger of relying too heavily on economic arguments. If we only worry about the species which provide us a given service, we risk losing a large amount of diversity.

The closer we look at the world around us, the more wonderful pieces of natural history we discover. When we experience the fascinating world of insects first-hand, the dominant dialogue of "insects as ecosystem service providers" begins to shift. Instead, we start to recognise the beauty, mystery and wonder of the insect world for what it is: beautiful, mysterious and wonderful. Through building a stronger appreciation of the important inherent value of insect biodiversity, hopefully "what do they do for us?" will share more space with "what can we do for them?".

Entomophagy An Alternative Protein Source

INTRODUCTION:

Entomophagy, from the Greek éntomos, "insect", and phágein, "eating". [Entomophagy](#), the consumption of insects as food, has been a common practice in many cultures for centuries. Actually, entomophagy is a practice that has always existed most probably already in the past and was a major and important source of livelihood as it is still today in some parts of the world. So it is not about the introduction of new foods but the spreading of a possible source of nutrition in the western world. Insects are currently consumed in different forms by an estimated 2 billion



people across Africa, Asia, Central and South America and Australia not only because they taste good but also because they are a nutritious and inexpensive food source. There are 1500-2000 species of recorded [edible insects](#) worldwide which constitutes a mere fraction of the 1,000,000 species of insects described to date. Globally, the most commonly consumed insects are the ones that are readily available such as beetles (Coleoptera: 31%), caterpillars (Lepidoptera: 18%), [bees](#), wasps, and ants (Hymenoptera: 14%), [grasshoppers](#), [locusts](#) and crickets (Orthoptera: 13%), [cicadas](#), [leafhoppers](#), [planthoppers](#), [scale insects](#), and true bugs (Hemiptera: 10%), termites (Isoptera: 3%), dragonflies (Odonata: 3%), flies (Diptera: 2%), and others (5%). The highest consumption of insects is in Africa, Asia, and Latin America. Despite their popularity in developing countries, [consumer acceptance](#) in Western countries is still very low, but this might change, as it did, for example, with [sushi](#). Insects can be consumed in whole or they can be incorporated in different dishes such as salads, sauces, cookies, and other [baked goods](#).

Benefits of Entomophagy

By 2050 the world's population is expected to reach or exceed 9 billion and global demand for food, feed, and fiber is expected to grow by 70%. Exacerbating this issue is the ever-increasing encroachment on some of the most productive [arable land](#) by sprawling urban and industrial development, and the increasing competition for fresh water between urban settlements and food production systems. Another conflict is the two-pronged attack on natural habitats and their incumbent biodiversity from both [urbanization](#) and food production. Finally, food production systems will need to adapt to global climate change even if mitigation of [greenhouse gas](#) production is successful in the near future. In summary, food producers will be forced to increase their output per unit of land while conserving precious freshwater resources.

Thus, alternative solutions to conventional livestock and feed sources urgently need to be developed. For this reason, insects show great potential for food and feed as an environmentally friendly choice in future food systems. Several beneficial aspects support an increased utilization of insects as a sustainable [animal protein](#) source. Insects are often high in protein, vitamins, and minerals. They have low

impact on resources and the environment by emitting less [greenhouse gases](#), requiring less water and space and are extremely efficient at converting ingested matter into [biomass](#) compared to their [vertebrate](#) counterparts in traditional husbandry. The consumption of insects, therefore, contributes positively to the environment and the human health.

Insect-Eating Events

Many “bug fests” and “bug feasts” have been taking place each year in some countries (Table 1). In the United States, a few of these include: events for the public held on university campuses such as the annual Bug Bowl sponsored by the Department of [Entomology](#), Purdue University and held on campus in West Lafayette, Indiana since 1990, the Fear Film Festival at University of Illinois, and the annual Bug Buffet at Montana State University since 1989, events for the public sponsored by insectaria or nature centers such as the BugFest at Garfield Park Nature Center in the Garfield Park Reservation, Cleveland, Ohio and portions of national meetings or special conferences such as the Food Insect Workshop held as part of the Insects in Captivity Conference, Tucson, Arizona. Additionally, the largest BugFest in the United States, in Raleigh, North Carolina, typically features a buffet of various insects cooked by several local and invited chefs and restaurants. They usually also have an insect-based food tasting contest judged by local media and prominent figures. Also, the Los Angeles County Natural History Museum (Los Angeles, California, USA) has an annual insect-themed festival at which there is an insect cooking competition. Additionally, the USA Science and Engineering Festival, in 2012 and 2014, had an invertebrate section (hosted by All Things Bugs, LLC in 2012 and Invertebrate Studies Institute in 2014) at which there were tables with various cooked and flavored insects for people to try.

Insect Protein Functionality

Very little information or research currently exists on the functionality of [insect protein](#), but as [entomophagy](#) becomes increasingly popular, more research in this area is being conducted. To that end, Yi et al. (2013) worked with the WHO/FAO to propose research that studied the functional properties of extracted insect proteins from the yellow mealworm, the superworm, the [lesser mealworm](#), the house cricket, and the Dubia cockroach. Their research determined that overall, the foaming capacity is very poor, likely due to the presence of oil in supernatant fractions. Gels were formed for all five insect species, using solutions from an aqueous extraction procedure. Additional research needs to be conducted to better understand the mechanism of gelation, and what happens to these gels when exposed to [shear](#) as well as

the sensory and rheological properties. In addition, additional work needs to be completed to better understand the foaming instability and if it is simply the oil present in the supernatant. This can be remedied by utilizing alternative extraction and purifying techniques to ensure the quality of the functional protein source.

Table 2: summarizes the currently available research on functional properties of a variety of insect species. A variety of insect species under certain processing conditions will solubilize in water, have water and fat absorption capacity, and have the capacity to form and stabilize gels and foams. The lipid concentration in many of these powders also allows for significant flavor binding to improve the flavor of the final product.

it is not widespread, as well as support and promote the entomophagy in cultures where it is already present. Conduct comprehensive research on the ecology of species potentially suitable for consumption or for breeding. Develop new ways to integrate insects into the diets of a wide range of consumers with the creation of products based on insects. Also, promote the use of insects as feed supplements for pets.

ESN Landed Property at University of Abuja:

Fencing of the land had commenced as the four corners of the land had been secured and some coaches of blocks had been raised at the back to secure the land. However, it is pertinent to note that members have not fully keyed into the vision as very few have paid the levy as agreed. Despite December 2019 deadline, the year is far spent and the response is nothing to write home about. So far, only 39 members of the Society had paid fully the levies as at the time of reporting while 4 members had made part payments. Thus A total of N1,110,000.00 had been realized and N1,235,066.79 had been expended with N320,000.00 borrowed from the main account of the Society to support the project.
